The Junior Comet Basketball League was established for the social and physical development for the players. The goals of the league are to teach basketball fundamentals, sportsmanship and a love of the game. We strive to create an opportunity for kids to work together as a team towards a common goal. Your support and encouragement will go a long way to helping achieve these goals.

Coaches must:

- Exemplify honesty, integrity and fair play not matter the circumstance.
- Honor the spirit and the letter of the rules. Promote sportsmanship over gamesmanship.
- Treat your players with respect and dignity and require them to treat each other, opposing players, coaches, officials and parents with respect.
- Not engage in or allow your players to trash talk, taunt or behave in ways that demean players on your team, players on opposing teams, officials or the game of basketball.
- Not engage in or permit profanity or obscene gestures.
- Not use physical or psychological intimidation or verbal abuse towards players.
- Control your ego and emotions. Displaying anger and frustration sends the wrong message to players and undermines the integrity of basketball.
- Treat game officials with respect. Don't complain or argue with an official. How you deal with game officials sets the tone for how your players and parents will deal with them.
